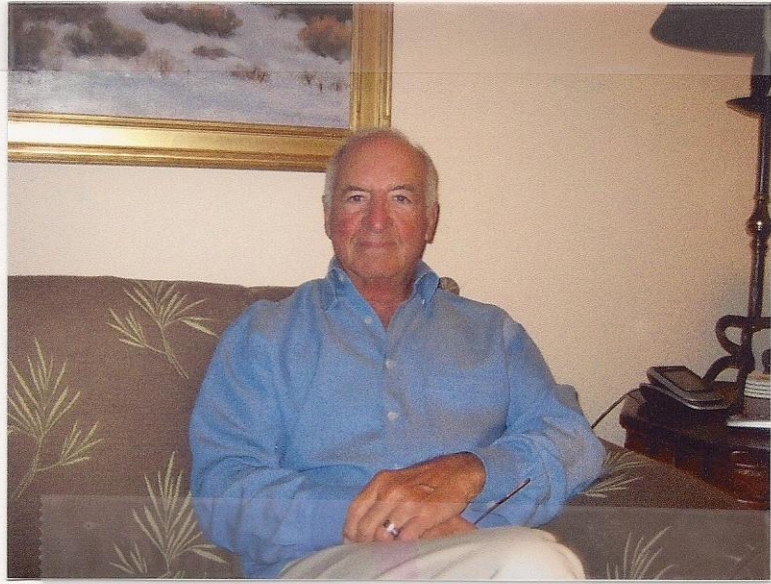


PAUL F ROTH
